The 30th June, 1997

No. G.S.R. 55/ Const. / Art. 309/97 — In exercise of powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Haryana hereby makes the following rules regulating the recruitment and conditions of service of persons appointed to the Directorate of Local Bodies, Haryana (Group B) Service, namely:-

PART I - GENERAL

1. (i) These rules may be called the Haryana Directorate of Local Bodies Department (Group B) Service Rules, 2009.

Short title and commencement

- 2. In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires :
 - a) "Commission" means the Haryana Public Service Commission;
 - b) "direct recruitment " means an appointment made otherwise than by promotion from within the service or by transfer of an official already in the service of the Government of India or any State Government;
 - c) "Director" means the Director Local Bodies, Haryana.
 - d) "Government" means the Haryana Government in the Administrative Department;
 - e) "Institution" means; -
 - (i) Any institution established by law in force in the State of Haryana; or
 - (ii) Any other institution recognized by the Government for the purpose of these rules.
 - f) "recognized university" means; -
 - (i) Any university incorporated by law in India; or
 - (ii) In the case of a degree, diploma or certificate obtained as a result of an examination held before the 15th August, 1947, the Punjab, Sind or Dacca University; or
 - (iii) Any other university which is declared by the Government to be a recognized university for the purpose of these rules.
 - g) "Service" means the Directorate of Local Bodies, Haryana (Group B) service.

Definitions

PART II - RECRUITMENT TO SERVICE

Number and character of posts

3. The Service shall comprise the posts shown in Appendix A to these rules:

Provided that nothing in these rules shall affect the inherent right of the Government to make additions to, or reduction in, the number of such posts or to create new posts with different designations and scales of pay, either permanently or temporarily.

Nationality, domicile and character of candidates appointed to service.

- 4. (1) No person shall be appointed to any post in the Service, unless he is, -
 - (a) a citizen of India; or
 - (b) a subject of Nepal; or
 - (c) a subject of Bhutan; or
 - (d) a Tibetan refugee who came over to India before the 1st January, 1962, with the intention of permanently setting in India; or
 - (e) a person of Indian origin who has migrated from Pakistan, Burma, Sri Lanka or any of the East African countries of Kenya, Uganda, the United Republic of Tanzania (formerly Tanganyika and Zanzibar), Zambia, Malawi, Zaire and Ethopia with the intention of permanently setting in India:

Provided that a person belonging to any of the categories (b), (c), (d) or (e) shall be a person in whose favour a certificate of eligibility has been issued by the Government.

- (2) A person in whose case a certificate of eligibility is necessary may be admitted to an examination or interview conducted by the Commission or any other recruiting authority, but the offer of appointment may be given after the necessary eligibility certificate has been issued to him by the Government.
- (3) No person shall be appointed to any post in the Service by direct recruitment, unless he produces a certificate of character from the Principal Academic Officer of the university, college, school or institution last attended, if any, and similar certificates from two other responsible persons, not being his relatives who are well acquainted with him in his private life and are un-connected with his university, college, school or institution.

5. No person shall be appointed to any post in the Service by direct recruitment who is less than twenty-one years or more than thirty five years of age, on or before the last of submission of application to the Commission or any other recruiting authority.

Appointing authority

6. Appointments to any post in the Service shall be made by the Government.

Qualification

7. No person, shall be appointed to any post in the Service, unless he is in possession of qualification and experience specified in column 3 of Appendix B to these rules in the case of direct recruitment and those specified in column 4 of the aforesaid Appendix in the case of appointment other than by direct recruitment:

Provided that in the case of direct recruitment, the qualifications regarding experience shall be relaxable to the extent of 50% at the discretion of the Commission or any other recruiting authority in case sufficient number of candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes, Backward Classes, Other Backward Classes, Ex-servicemen and Physically Handicapped categories, Possessing the requisite experience are not available to fill up the vacancies reserved for them, after recording reasons for so doing in writing.

8. No person, -

Disqualifications

- (a) Who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
- (b) Who having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be, eligible for appointment to any post in the Service.

Provided that the Government may, if satisfied, that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

9. (1) Recruitment to the Service shall be made, -

Method of recruitment

- (a) In the case of Sub-Divisional Engineer-cum-Assistant Engineer, -
 - (i) By promotion from amongst Junior Engineer; or
 - (ii) By direct recruitment; or
 - (iii) By transfer or deputation of an officer/official already in the service of any State Government or the Government of India;
- (b) In the case of Accounts Officer, -
 - (i) By transfer or deputation from the Director, Local audit Department or Treasury and Accounts Department Haryana.

- (c) In the case of Assistant District Attorney, -
 - (i) By transfer or deputation from the office of Director, Prosecution, Haryana.
- (d) In the case of Assistant Town Planner, -
 - (i) by direct recruitment; and
 - (ii) By transfer or depuration of an officer already in any of the service of any State Government or the Government of India;
- (e) In the case of Assistant Director, Elections. -
 - (i) By promotion from amongst Superintendent; or
 - (ii) By transfer or deputation of an officer already in the service of any State Government or the Government of India.

Note: - The post of Assistant Director, Elections involves the assumption of duties and responsibilities of greater importance than those of the post of Superintendent.

- (f) In the case of Superintendent; -
 - (i) By promotion from Deputy Superintendent Assistant, personal Assistant and Senior Scale Stenographer; or
 - (ii) By transfer or deputation of an officer already in the service of any State Government or the Government of India.
- (2) All promotions unless otherwise provided, shall be made on the seniority-cummerit basis and seniority alone shall not confer any right to such promotions.
- 10.(1) Persons appointed to any post in the Service shall remain on probation for a period of two years, if appointed by direct recruitment, and one year, if appointed otherwise

Provided that -

- (a) Any period, after such appointment, spent on deputation on corresponding or a higher post shall count towards the period of probation;
- (b) Any period of work in equivalent or higher rank, prior to appointment to the Service may, in the case of an appointment by transfer, at the discretion of the appointing authority, be allowed to count towards the period of probation fixed under this rule; and
- (c) Any period of officiating appointment shall be reckoned as period spent on probation but no person who has so officiated shall, on the completion of the prescribed period of probation, be entitled to be conferment, unless he is appointed against a permanent vacancy.
- (2) if, in the opinion of the appointing authority the work or conduct of a person during the period of probation is not satisfactory, it may, -

- (a) if such person is appointed by direct recruitment, dispense with his service; and
- (b) if such person is appointed otherwise than by direct recruitment, -
 - (i) revert him to his former post; or
- (ii) deal with him in such other manner as the terms and conditions of the previous appointment permit.
- (3) On the completion of the period of probation of a person, the appointing authority may, -
 - (a) if his work or conduct has, in this opinion been satisfactory, -
- (i) confirm such person from the date of his appointment, if appointed against a permanent vacancy; or
- (ii) confirm such person from the date from which a permanent vacancy occurs, if appointed against a temporary; or
- (iii) declare that he has completed his probation satisfactorily, if there is no permanent vacancy; or
 - (b) if his work or conduct has, in its opinion, been not satisfactory, -
 - dispense with his service, if appointed by direct recruitment, if appointed otherwise, revert him to his former post, or deaf with him in such other manner as the terms and conditions of previous appointment permit; or
 - (ii) extend his period of probation and thereafter pass such order, as it could have passed on the expiry of the first period of probation:

Provided that the total period of probation, including extension, if any, shall not exceed three years.

11. Seniority, inter- se, of members of the Service shall determined by the length of continuous Service on any post in the Service:

Seniority.

Provided that where there are different cadres in the Service, the seniority shall be determined separately for each cadre:

Provided further that in the case of members appointed by direct recruitment, the order of merit determined by the Commission or any other recruiting authority, as the case may be, shall not be disturbed in fixing the seniority:

Provided further that in the case of two or more members appointed on the same dates, their seniority shall be determined as follows: -

- (a) a member appointed by direct recruitment shall be senior to a member appointed by promotion or by transfer;
- (b) a member appointed by promotion shall be senior to a member appointed by transfer;
- (c) in the case of members appointed by promotion or by transfer, seniority shall be determined according to the seniority of such

- members in the appointments from which they were promoted or transferred; and
- (d) in the case of members appointed by transfer from different cadres. Their seniority shall be determined according to pay,

preference being given to a member, who was drawing a higher rate of pay in his previous appointment: and if the rates of pay drawn are also the same, then by the length of their service in the appointment and if the length of such service is also the same the older member shall be senior to the younger member.

Liability to serve.

- 12. (1) A member of the Service shall be liable to serve at any place, whether within or outside the State of Haryana, on being ordered to do so by the appointing authority.
 - (2) A member of the Service may also be deputed to serve under: -
- (i) a company, an association or a body of individuals whether incorporated or not, which is wholly or substantially owned or controlled by the State Government, a Municipal Corporation or a local authority or university within the State of Haryana; or
- (ii) the Central Government or a company, an association or a body of individuals, whether incorporated or not, which is wholly or substantially owned or controlled by the Central Government; or
 - (iii) any other State Government, an international organization, an autonomous body not controlled by the Government or a private body:

Provided that no member of the Service shall be deputed to serve under the Central or any other State Government or any organization or body referred to in clause(ii) or clause (iii) except with his consent.

Pay, leave, Pension and other matters

13. In respect of pay, leave, pension and all other matters not expressly provided for in these rules, the members of the Service shall be governed by such rules and regulations as may have been, or may hereafter be, adopted or made by the competent authority under the Constitution of India or under any law for the time being in force made by the State Legislature.

Discipline, Penalties and appeals.

14.(1) In matters relating to discipline, penalties and appeals, members of the service shall be governed by the Haryana Civil Services (Punishment and Appeal) Rules, 1987, as amended from time to time:

Provided that the nature of penalties which may be imposed, the authority empowered to impose such penalties and appellate authority shall, subject to the provisions of any law or rules made under article 309 of the Constitution of India, be such as are specified in Appendix C to these rules.

(2) The authority competent to pass order under clause (c)or clause (d) of sub-rule (1) of rule 9 of the Haryana Civil Services (Punishment and Appeal) Rules, 1987, and the appellate authority shall be as specified in Appendix D to these rules.

Vaccination

15. Every member of the Service, shall get himself vaccinated or revaccinated as and when the Government so directs by the special or general order.

16. Every member of the Service, unless he has already done so, shall be required to take the oath of allegiance to India and to the Constitution of India as by law established.

Oath of allegiance.

17. Where the Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient to do so, it may be order, for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category or persons.

Power of relaxatio

18. Notwithstanding anything contained in these rules, the appointing authority may impose special terms and conditions, in order of appointment if it is deemed expedient to do so.

Special Provision

19. Nothing contained in these rules shall after reservations and other concessions required to be provided for Scheduled Castes, Backward Classes, Other Backward Classes, Ex-servicemen, Physically handicapped persons or any other class or category of persons in accordance with order issued by the State Government in this regard from time to time:

Reservations.

Provided that the total percentage of reservations so made shall not exceed fifty percent, at any time.

Repeal and savings

20. Any rule applicable to the Service and Corresponding to any of these rules which is in force immediately before the commencement of these rules is hereby repealed:

Provided that any order made or action taken under the rules so repealed shall be deemed to have been made or taken under corresponding provisions of these rules.
